

PRIVACY NOTICE

Your privacy is important to us at Hunter Homes. We realize that privacy is a valuable asset, and we want to ensure that you are protected by a privacy policy where personal information is treated with the utmost confidentiality. We therefore will not share or sell your confidential information with third parties, except as permitted by law. If and when we do share this information, we will follow strict security standards and confidentiality policies, and comply with applicable laws regarding the use of this information.

This Privacy Notice is designed to inform you generally of the types of information we collect and under what circumstances that information is shared. The provisions of this Privacy Notice apply to all former, current, and future Hunter Homes customers. Please read this Privacy Notice carefully and keep it with your records.

Information we may collect: Throughout our relationship with you, Hunter Homes may obtain personal information about you. Much of the information we obtain about you comes directly from your inquiries, via our website or through your responses to our mailings and over the phone, or generally when you communicate with us about your interest in our homes. This information may include your name, address, social security number, and your income and assets. We may also obtain information from outside sources, including credit reporting agencies and your employer. This information may include your credit history, your loan and credit card balances with other lenders, and your employment history.

What we do with the information we collect: At Hunter Homes, we restrict access to the information we have collected about you to those employees who need to know that information in order to further explore the opportunity for you to own a Hunter Home. We also maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect your information.

Sharing with affiliates: We are permitted by law to share with our affiliates information related solely to our experiences or transactions with you. (Affiliates are the companies within the Hunter Homes family.)

Sharing with non-affiliated third parties: Non-affiliated third parties are entities that are not within the Hunter Homes family of companies. We share our information with non-affiliated third parties only as permitted or required by law. The types of sharing permitted or required by law include the following:

- We may share your information with companies with which we have contracted to provide services in connection with our homes with which we have joint marketing agreements.
- We may share your information in order to complete your home purchase (such as providing a closing attorney or mortgage lender with the information necessary to close your loan).
- We may share your information with credit reporting agencies.

- We may share your information when required by law to disclose such information to appropriate authorities, as, for example, in response to a valid court order or subpoena.
- We may share your information at your request or authorization.
